## EXHIBITOR SPACE DETAILS

**BOOTHS:** The approximate size of each booth is 10-feet deep x 10-feet wide. Exhibitors can pay for two booths if they require additional space. Space is limited for double-booths. With each booth, exhibitors will also receive a table and two chairs. Exhibitors are welcome to bring their own, additional folding chairs.

**ELECTRICITY:** A very limited number of booths will have electrical hookup (120 volt). These are available, first-come, first-served, for an additional charge of \$100. Exhibitors must provide their own heavy-duty 20-foot extension cord.

**EXHIBITOR'S RESPONSIBILITY AND SETUP:** The exhibitor will have at least one individual in charge of their space and in attendance at its exhibit throughout the day. Times for exhibit setup are between 7 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. on the day of the expo. The Clover Crawl opens promptly at 10 a.m. and ends at 4 p.m.
